



## Willis Allen Kiser

February 26, 1926 - June 15, 2008

Willis Allen Kiser, 82, of Butler, PA, died at 5:15 AM Sunday, June 15, 2008 at his residence after succumbing to multiple myeloma.

He was born Friday, February 26, 1926 in Center Twp., Butler Co., PA, at their family farm. He is the son of the late Henry Braden Kiser and the late Norma Fern (Shakley) Kiser.

He was a member of Faith United Presbyterian Church, Moose #64, American Legion Post #117, and Sheffield V.F.W. He attended a one room school house at Stoney Run and was a 1943 graduate of Butler High School. He attended Slippery Rock College for one year, then was employed at West Penn Power (Now Allegheny Power) as a supervising foreman. Upon his retirement in 1988, he and his wife enjoyed traveling to visit their children and grandchildren across the US, England, Scotland, Egypt, and Singapore. His lifelong interests included supporting the Steelers, being outdoors, hunting and fishing, and being "at camp".

A true example of "the greatest generation ever", he enlisted in the Army Air Corps. at the age of 17, and was stationed at Harlington, TX.
